

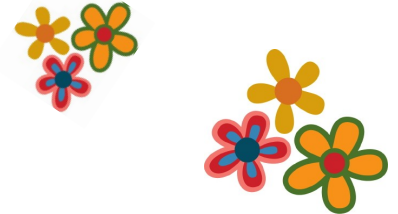

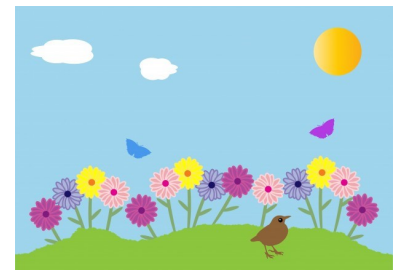
## COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT STRAND
