**REGISTRATION**

**LODGING**

You must make your own hotel reservations at the Hyatt Regency at Los Angeles Airport Hotel (6225 West Century Boulevard, Los Angeles, CA 90045) prior to ***January 18, 2018***, to receive the CCA negotiated rate. The CCA negotiated room rate with the Hyatt Regency is:

**\$139 (plus applicable taxes) per night for single or double occupancy**

Please make your own hotel reservations [online](#) or call Central Reservations at **(888) 421-1442** and refer to “**CCA Winter Conference**” to receive the CCA negotiated rate.

To guarantee a room, you must supply a valid credit card number. Delegate lodging expenses will be reimbursed by CCA according to its Bylaws. CCA will pay one-half the cost of a double-occupancy room. Each delegate is expected to share a room with another delegate. Delegates wishing a single room must pay the difference between a double and single room except in extenuating circumstances. Prior authorization is required. **PLEASE NOTE: Delegates Must Attend All Sessions To Be Eligible For Lodging Reimbursement.** Delegates are responsible for paying the hotel bill upon checkout.

TO RECEIVE THE CCA NEGOTIATED RATE.**

If a chapter is allocated less than four delegates, the remaining participants will attend as non-delegates. For non-delegates not covered by CCA Standing Rules, registration fees are \$300.
